## UAE committed to protecting and conserving natural environment

H.E. Dr. Muhammad Saeed Al Kindi, Minister of Environment and Water of the United Arab Emirates spoke with Helene Rang, CEO of NUMOV / German Near and Middle East Association

H.R.: The establishment of a Ministry of Environment Water (MEW) in the UAE underlines the importance environmental issues for your government. In what areas has the ministry gained its most visiachievements so far?
