H.R.: Industry and Trade Minister Khaled Rajeh Sheikh underscored on 3 October 2005 that Yemen is committed to accession to the WTO as "a necessary step and an important component in our efforts to integrate into the world economy". Which actions will now be taken in order to meet the WTO requirements?

H.E. Ahmed Mohammed Sofan: Yemen is currently progressing in the processing of all the requirements of the accession, and at this stage, many laws related to trade are being revised and amendments proposals are being prepared. Once these proposals have been discussed and
