German Vice Chancellor and Federal Minister for Economic Affairs and Climate Action, H.E. Dr. Robert Habeck, travelled to Qatar and the United Arab Emirates from 19th to 21st March 2022 to discuss long-term sustainable energy cooperation. Joined by a German business delegation, the visit enhanced commercial, industrial and investment relations between Germany and Qatar, establishing joint cooperation for the long-term purchase of liquid natural gas from Qatar and the development of LNG-receiving terminals in Germany. The meetings that took place in the UAE also saw a number of bilateral hydrogen agreements concluded as well as a German-Emirati research deal aimed at strengthening the transition to a sustainable economy and at ensuring the future supply of energy to Germany.
