Interview with H.E. Olaf Scholz,
Federal Chancellor of Germany, by Helene Rang, NUMOV



The MENA region has been experiencing an increase in attention and interest from Germany over the past months. In particular, the Russian war against Ukraine has necessitated Germany to diversify its energy suppliers. How does the government look at the region overall?

The Russian war of aggression against Ukraine has highlighted the importance of peace and stability in our neighbourhood as well as diversification. As you rightly point out, a stronger energy cooperation with different countries in the region will help us reduce dependencies on Russia. It should also contribute to the global transition to renewable energies. However, our perspective on the MENA region is not

limited to energy policies. We aim to enhance our relationships in a number of fields.

High-ranking bilateral meetings have included those with Egypt, Oman, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates. What potentials for enhanced cooperation do you see with these countries?

In addition to energy cooperation, climate change is an important priority. COP27 takes place in Egypt this year, COP28 in the United Arab Emirates next year. In order to promote the implementation of the Paris climate agreement, we need to move quickly. At the same time, countries in the region are important trade and investment partners. We want to step up our cooperation. In addition, an enhanced
