NUMOV's successful delegation visit to Qatar



In an effort to further strengthen German-Qatari economic cooperation, the German Near and Middle East Association / NUMOV, organized a high-level delegation visit to Qatar between 30th August and 1st September 2025. Comprising 25 senior representatives from leading German businesses and industries, the delegation was led by Silvio Konrad, Member of the Board of NUMOV and COO Business Unit Energy & Resources at TÜV NORD GROUP. NUMOV is grateful to the German Embassy in Doha for its support and assistance in preparing this important business mission.

The delegation engaged in a series of strategic meetings with Qatari government institutions, private sector leaders, and investment organizations. The visit yielded valuable new partnerships and reinforced existing business

ties between Germany and Qatar. Important to know: This was the first mission of a foreign business delegation to Qatar after the summer recess. The NUMOV delegation thus sent a strong signal of international cooperation "Made in Germany" with this key Gulf state, which stands as the largest Arab investor in Germany. At the beginning of the visit, the delegation convened on 30th August 2025 for a preparatory briefing at the German embassy. The session offered delegates an overview of the economic landscape of Qatar and the Gulf region, along with practical guidance on conducting business in the country.

Acting German Ambassador Hans-Udo Muzel offered detailed information on the organizations and institutions the delegation would meet during their stay, setting the stage for a productive and well-informed series of
